Respondent continued to engaged in a romantic relationship with a female patient after being placed on probation in June 2008. Respondent also prescribed controlled substances to patients without a consulting physician and outside of a consultation and referral plan. Respondent has violated probationary terms and conditions that exist on his license.

Respondent voluntarily surrendered his licenses to practice as an advanced practice registered nurse and to administer and prescribe controlled substances. Respondent may not reapply for a nursing license for a period of five years. October 20, 2009

The probationary condition requiring Respondent to receive prescriptions from only one prescribing practitioner was amended to allow Respondent to receive prescriptions from two prescribing practitioners, but only one of the prescribing practitioners can prescribed controlled substances to her.
