Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct prior to submitting an application for licensure.

A license to practice as a burglar alarm company agent was issued and said license was placed on probation for two years with conditions and restrictions. August 24, 2011

The probation on Respondent's license to practice as a massage therapist was terminated and said license was reinstated with full privileges. August 1, 2011

Respondents engaged in unprofessional conduct when the licensed funeral establishment does not contain a refrigeration room that can maintain a temperature of 40 degrees Fahrenheit or less for the preservation of dead human bodies as required by Utah statute which came into effect in 2009. Respondent's licenses to practice as a funeral service director and as a funeral service establishment were given a public reprimand. Respondents were also ordered to cease and desist from engaging in the unprofessional conduct identified in the Stipulation/Order. Respondents are also required to bring the licensed funeral establishment into full compliance with statutory refrigeration requirements within 90 days. Respondent Coby Swindlehurst is also required to submit a letter to the Division within 60 days indicating he has reviewed/read applicable laws and rules. August 9, 2011

The Division's July 5, 2011 Default Order in which Respondent's license to practice as an armed private security officer was revoked has been set aside and further proceedings will be conducted in this matter. August 17, 2011
