Respondent engaged in unprofessional and unlawful conduct with regards to inappropriate prescriptions to allow others to obtain controlled substances and legend drugs for use in a body and laser center.

Respondent's licenses to practice as a physician/surgeon and to administer and prescribe controlled substances were given a public reprimand as a result of the conduct identified above. Respondent was also ordered to pay a \$1,000 fine within 90 days. Respondent was also ordered to cease and desist from engaging in the unprofessional conduct identified in this Order. August 13, 2012

Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct related to a methadone prescription given to a patient in December 2008. Due to a number of complicating factors, including the patient's failure to disclose detoxification treatment in early December 2008, the patient's failure to disclose the obtainment of a benzodiazepine prescription during the same time period, and Respondent's problematic methadone prescription, the patient was found deceased at his home on December 26, 2008. Respondent was given a public reprimand for the above conduct, ordered to attend the PACE (Physician Assessment and Clinical Education Program) prescribing course offered through the University of California, San Diego's School of Medicine, which he has completed, and was ordered to seek peer review when prescribing and using methadone for the treatment of pain with his patients in new or complicated cases.

Respondent's license to practice as a physician/surgeon in Illinois was disciplined in April 2012.

Respondent voluntarily surrendered his licenses to practice as a physician/surgeon and to administer and prescribe controlled substances in this state. Respondent may not reapply for a physician/surgeon license for five years. August 16, 2012

Respondent was disciplined by the Kansas Medical Board in October 2011 for conduct that would constitute grounds for disciplinary action if the conduct had occurred in Utah.

Said licenses are suspended until Respondent has completed a required competency evaluation. Following the period of suspension, both licenses will be placed on probation for five years with conditions and restrictions. August 22, 2012

Respondent allowed his license to practice as a dentist to expire on May 31, 2012 which is in violation of probationary conditions that existed on his license.
